The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Personal identifiers, contacts and characteristics (name, contact details, email address, date of birth, gender)

How we get the personal information and why we have it

The personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for membership of the British Minigolf Association.

We use the information that you have given us in order to communicate with you and to categorise players in tournaments, for example by age or gender.

If you are selected for an international tournament we will supply the World Minigolf Sports Federation with your name, gender and date of birth.

We will not share any information with other organisations or individuals.

Under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the lawful base we rely on for processing this information is your consent. **You are able**

to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting chairman@minigolf.org.uk

How we store your personal information

Your information is securely stored.

We keep your personal information while you are a member of the British Minigolf Association. Once you cease to be a member we will dispose of your information by deleting it from our files. This will occur the day after the Annual General Meeting following the end of the year when you were a last a member or earlier if you send a request to chairman@minigolf.org.uk.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights including:

Your right of access - You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information.

Your right to rectification - You have the right to ask us to rectify personal information you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.

Your right to erasure - You have the right to ask us to erase your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to restriction of processing - You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to object to processing - You have the the right to object to the processing of your personal information in certain circumstances.

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal information you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you.

How to complain

If you have any concerns about our use of your personal information, you can make a complaint to us at chairman@minigolf.org.uk.

You can also complain to the ICO if you are unhappy with how we have used your data.
